Reading and Vocabulary Exercises: categorising, matching, listing, guessing

Focus

Summer vocabulary

Aim

To learn and practice vocabulary associated with summer.

Preparation

Make one copy of the two-page worksheet for each student.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this summer vocabulary worksheet, students learn and practice common words associated with summer.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the two-page worksheet.

To begin, students read a short text about summer. The students then categorize the summer vocabulary from the text.

Exercise A - Answer key

Summer activities: swimming, surfing, camping, picnic

Places people go in summer: beach, park, swimming pool

Things people wear in summer: shorts, sunglasses, swimming costume, cap, sunscreen

Other words associated with summer: sunny, sunburn, ice cream, holiday

Next, students match sentence halves together that use collocations associated with summer.

Exercise B - Answer key

After that, the students match each summer word with its correct definition.

Exercise C - Answer key

The students then go on to write two answers for each item shown, e.g. 'Write down two things you take with you to the beach'.

Finally, students work with a partner and take it in turns to guess the two answers their partner wrote for each item. Students are allowed two guesses each time and score one point for each correct answer. The student with the most points wins.
